← NO PARKING →

RULES

1. ANY FAIR FLY BALL HIT OVER THE FENCE IS A HOME RUN.
2. ANY FAIR BALL ENTERING THE WOODS ON THE GROUND OR IN THE AIR IS A HOME RUN.
3. ANY FAIR BALL ENTERING THE PARKING LOT SOUTH OF THE FENCE IS A HOME RUN.
4. ANY BATTED BALL BY ROLL OR BOUNCE ENTERING THE PARKING LOT IS A DOUBLE INCLUDING BALLS THAT ROLL UNDER THE FENCE OR STRIKE THE OUTFIELD BUMPERS.
5. OUT OF BOUNDS IN RIGHT FIELD IS FROM THE FRONT EDGE OF THE BACKSTOP TO THE FOUL POLE AND PARALLEL TO THE FOUL LINES.
6. TREES HANGING OVER THE RIGHT FIELD FOUL LINE ARE OUT OF PLAY SHOULD ANY BATTED BALL FIRST HIT TREE LIMBS BEFORE BEING CAUGHT. IF CAUGHT IN FAIR TERRITORY, BATTER IS NOT OUT.
7. BALLS HIT OVER RESIDENTIAL FENCES ARE NOT TO BE RETRIEVED UNLESS THE HOMEOWNER GIVES PERMISSION.
